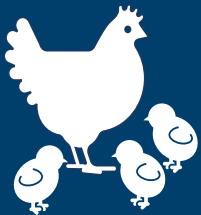


Stay Healthy

Do not drink raw milk products.

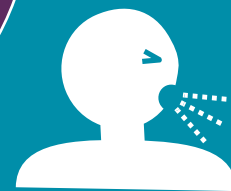
Wash hands after working with animals or in their environment.
